1. Under the settlement agreement approved by the Court, Defendant Trans Union agreed to pay Named Plaintiff Franklin E. Clark an incentive award of up to \$1,000.00, subject to Court approval, for efforts and risks undertaken on behalf of the class.

2. This litigation is now four years old. During that time Clark has, among other things, remained in contact with and cooperated with Class Counsel, provided deposition testimony and other evidentiary information, attended a hearing, and been subjected to publicity and inconvenience in his role as class representative.
